Inner Governmental Agreement

- Jim, Jody, Jerry, and Lyn met on 11/23 and 11/30 to wordsmith a counter-proposal for the County Commissioners.
- 5 recommendation made to modify the IGA
 - 1. Invite all commissioners to the BOH meetings and provide them with minutes from each meeting
 - 2. Amend bylaws to allow more than 7 members on BOH

- 3. Proposed amendments to the IGA should be allowed at any time, not only at bi-annual review
- 4. Changed effective date to 1/1/21
- 5. Develop method for handling complaints and enforcement to take some burden off commissioners.
- 2 alternatives to the commissioner proposal
 - 1. Keep IGA as is 2 commissioners (1 from each county) and 3 members at large
 - 2. Amend IGA to have 4 commissioners (2 from each county) and 4 members at large

Further Discussion

- Take out wording "maximum" and "minimum"
- Is there a purpose of bi-annual review? To streamline the process
